Ordinances Relative to Transient Vendor Licenses

5.12.010 - Defined.

"Transient vendor," for the purposes of this chapter, means as defined in Section 1 of Chapter 101 of the General Laws.
(Prior revision § 9-11)

5.12.020 - License required—Application.

A.

Every transient vendor, before making any sale of goods, wares or merchandise in the city, shall apply to the city council for a license, and shall accompany any such application with a license fee as set out in Table I of this revision. Thereupon the city council shall authorize the city clerk to issue a license to the applicant, authorizing the sale of goods, wares and merchandise, which license shall remain in force so long as the licensee shall continuously keep and expose for sale in the city such stock of goods, wares or merchandise, but not later than the first day of January following its date.

B.

Subsection A notwithstanding, any person declared to be a "blind person" as described in Section 133 of Chapter 6 of the Massachusetts General Laws, who has registered with the Massachusetts Commission for the Blind, as provided for by Section 135 of Chapter 6 of the Massachusetts General Laws, shall be exempted from the license fee set out in Table I of this revision.

5.12.030 - State license required—Display of license.

A.

No license shall be granted under this article until the applicant has complied with the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 101, Section 3, and has exhibited to the city clerk a license.

B.

Any licensee who fails, neglects or refuses to exhibit a license granted under the provisions of this chapter and applicable Massachusetts General Laws when the same is demanded to be displayed by the sealer of weights and measures, agents of the board of health or a police officer shall be subject to the same penalty as if the person had no license.

5.12.040 - Revocation of license.

The city clerk is authorized to revoke any license issued under the provisions of this chapter where the licensee is guilty of violating any provisions of this chapter or any provisions of laws or ordinances which violation would make such licensee a person unfit to hold the license.
