Public Hearing Notice
Proposed FY 2019 Annual Plan
HUD Community Development Block Grant Program

The City of Revere, acting through its Chief Executive Officer, Mayor Brian Arrigo, is a HUD Community Development Entitlement Community in the Federal Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) and is required to submit a FY 2019 Annual Plan detailing its planned use of funds. The City of Revere expects to receive approximately \$790,383 for its FY 2019 CDBG Program.**

On Wednesday, April 24, 2019, the Office of Strategic Planning and Economic Development (OSPED) will hold the second of two public hearings on the proposed use of funds under the Annual Plan for FY 2019, which is CDBG Program Year July 1, 2019 - June 30, 2020. This hearing will provide an opportunity for the public to comment on the draft FY 2019 Annual Plan. This hearing will be held at 6:00pm in the Community Room of the Revere Police Department, located at 400 Revere Beach Parkway, Revere, MA.

The OSPED has established a 30 day comment period on the Annual Plan. From on or about April 8-May 8, 2019, the FY 2019 Annual Plan will be available for public review during regular business hours at the OSPED, Mezzanine Level, City Hall, 281 Broadway, Revere, MA 02151. The draft Annual Plan will also be posted on the City's website (www.revere.org). Written comments must be received by 4:00pm on the final day of the comment period, expected to be May 8, 2019. Such comments will be considered by the OSPED and responded to in the formal plan to be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on or before May 15, 2019 following the conclusion of the formal comment period.

Persons with speech, hearing, or sight disabilities and persons requiring translation services will be accommodated at the public hearings to the greatest extent possible provided a request for such assistance is made at a reasonable time prior to the hearing to the OSPED at the above address, by telephone at 781-286-8137, or by email to tleng@revere.org. The Community Room at the Revere Police headquarters where the hearing will be held is fully accessible.

**This stated amount assumes level or similar funding to Federal FY 2018. At the time of this notice, Congressional appropriations for HUD have not yet been finalized, and funding allocations from HUD for the City of Revere for FY 2019 are subject to change.
